

- Completed Application
- Official sealed transcripts from your High School showing your cumulative GPA from your 9th, 10th and 11th grade years combined (on a 4.0 scale)
- 3 letters of recommendation, each from one of the following:
 - A teacher
 - A community leader
 - A person of your choice (that is not related to you)
- A 500 word essay describing the dream you are pursuing and what significant roadblock, setback or challenge you have faced along the way
